Carol reported that the Lake Country Power Operation Roundup application has been submitted with a decision due in mid-December.

Natural Harvest has approved the Friends for their 2021 round-up program.

Give-to-the-Max Day is near. Char will contact Josh Gillson as to present status and then she will get this set up.

Carol is working with Tim Johnson on State Farm's Quotes-For-Good fund raiser, which will run in January and February.

Char reported briefly on Bonfire's T-shirt fund raiser and will be providing more information.

Nancy reported that with SHPO mostly complete she will begin work on a plant survey and natural heritage.

Carol reported she had conversation with some land owners in the area of the south end of the west segment with positive feelings.

Steve Lotz reported that he had received a renewal notice from the Parks & Trails Council for 2021 with dues in the amount of \$35.00. Motion by Carol, second by Caroline, to renew the Friends membership for \$35.00. No further discussion, six ayes, motion carried. Steve will forward the bill to Caroline.
